Reminders for a Successful Irrigation Season

Even without many winter showers, it is time for May flowers! Todd Creek is a beautiful area with many plant-filled properties and TCVM is proud to provide non-potable irrigation water to help those plants blossom. Here are several reminders for the irrigation season:

- ◆ **TCVMD Rules & Regulations do not permit the use of potable water for irrigation purposes.** District staff actively monitors and fines for potable water violations.
- ◆ **The spigots on the outside, but attached to your home, are connected to your potable water system.** They should be reserved for human and pet use.
- ◆ **All sprinkler systems are required to be connected to TCVM's non-potable water distribution system.** This water is minimally treated and should not be directly consumed by humans, although it is safe to touch and be around. You should use this water for all outside irrigation watering of sod, shrubs, trees, plants, etc. **TCVM's non-potable irrigation water is the same type of water used for our wonderful local farms, so it should also be used for home edible gardens.**
- ◆ **A yard-hydrant or hose spigot attached to your irrigation system can be used to water all plants.** If your property does not have a yard-hydrant, it is recommended to consult with your landscape professional about the potential of adding one to your system. This system add-on has been advantageous for many customers during warm and/or dry stretches of fall, winter, and early spring.
- ◆ **TCVM always recommends hiring a professional to operate your system.** The District also recommends using the property's meter as a tool to ensure the stop-and-waste valve is in the correct position and the system is operating as expected to avoid water waste and unexpectedly large bills.



Being a TCVM customer means TCVM is your sole water provider. Therefore, your property is only subject to water use regulations, including restrictions, prescribed by Todd Creek Village Metropolitan District (TCVM). You are always welcome to reach our office with any questions.
